Deadlines for adding, dropping, and withdrawing from summer courses, along with the refund dates for these actions, are posted with each course in the Schedule of Classes. Each course may have different dates and deadlines. To view these deadlines, go to classes.uoregon.edu and find the course, then click on the CRN of the course (the five-digit number that is underlined) to get to the detail page about the course.

Note about Summer grades: in most cases, instructors are expected to submit grades within a reasonable time after their classes end; e.g., classes that end on a Friday should be submitted during the following week, preferably by Tuesday. Some departments may state earlier deadlines to facilitate pre-requisite checking for summer sequences.
